OPPI Student Delegate

The position of Student Delegate on Council presents an exciting opportunity for a student to take a leadership role, become involved in OPPI issues and initiatives, and represent the interests of planning students across Ontario. As the Student Delegate you participate as a voting member on OPPI Council and Chair the 12 member OPPI Student Liaison Committee. The Student Delegate's term of office is one year and runs from June to June.

Role and Responsibilities of the Student Delegate

- Attend Attend Council meetings (5) and representing student interests and conveying information to Student Members about Institute initiatives and activities.
- Promote student awareness of OPPI, and Student Membership in the Institute, by visiting the planning programs recognized by OPPI and promoting student-oriented activities, initiatives and research through regular submissions to the *Ontario Planning Journal*.
- Represent OPPI at the annual CAPS conference.
- Encourage student involvement in the various programs, activities and working committees at both the provincial and district levels.
- Provide leadership and maintaining regular liaison with the OPPI student representatives at each of the recognized planning programs.
- Attend and participate in the promotion and development of Student Day at the OPPI Conference or Symposium.
(All related and approved expenses are paid for by OPPI.)

Nominations

Nominations of candidates for election as Student Delegate to the OPPI Council will be accepted at the OPPI office up until the end of the nearest business day (4:30 p.m.) before March 1st. The nomination form must be completed and endorsed by two (2) OPPI Student Members in good standing. All candidates must submit a brief biography and a position statement (one page maximum) with their nomination form.

Voting

Ballots will be sent electronically to all OPPI Student Members in March. Ballots will be accepted up until the end of the nearest business day (4:30 p.m.) before April 15th.

An announcement of the successful candidate will be made in the *Ontario Planning Journal*.
